We are offering the benefits of our woodland space to local families/small groups whose members may not be able to adhere to social-distancing and require a degree of privacy (away from public spaces) to be able to safely enhance their well-being and mindfulness.

This space is hugely beneficial to those most affected by the pandemic, specifically those with special needs, the vulnerable and those suffering the effects of loneliness from forced isolation/shielding. Additionally, those whose family situation during lock-down, has not been conducive to their well-being.

MIH have seen the immediate positive effects that our rural space and animals has on our current learners and would like to widen the scope for others to be able to appreciate the mindfulness and well-being that our countryside has to offer and just how valuable it is to peoples physical and mental health and continued well-being.

This project offers secluded areas, giving you the chance to connect with nature, self-regulate and safely interact within your own bubble and not be met with social distancing requirements that you may face in public areas.

All aspects of development for this project has involved our community and other community organisations where possible and all purchases have been made from locally independent suppliers to help kick-start/boost the local economy. What our 'Family Retreat' can offer:

We have various areas available to families, within our beautiful woodland area, where you can sit and relax, either outdoors, under our parachute sheltered area, camp inside our various tent spots or cosy up in our new Woodland Hub.

Alternatively have a small walk through our woodland, where we have created a beautiful, guided pathway, dressed especially for a lovely and relaxing Christmassy, winter wonderland feel.

Brush up on your Wildlife knowledge, with our 'Facts about Wildlife' information points, staggered throughout our short woodland walk.

Enjoy time as a family and play some of our giant outdoor games, or woodland activities that have been set up around the Woodland areas.

Cosy up around an open fire, or even cook your own BBQ lunch!!

Our Woodland area now offers toilet facilities, running water for handwashing, a direct accessible route down to our woodland area (away from the main provision), where parking is available, as well as accessible pathways around the retreat.

What we will provide as part of your 'Family Day' & additional extras available

The Multiple Intelligence Hub will offer a variety of games and recreational activities as part of the experience. Should you require any additional 'Wildlife Craft Packs', we kindly request a donation of £2 per pack.

2 Fire Pits are available as part of the experience. Should you require us to supply firewood and kindling, we kindly ask for a donation of £5 per pack (which should last up to 2 hours).

1 small BBQ is available as part of the experience. Should you require us to supply coal for this, we kindly ask for a donation of £5 per pack. Visitors will be expected to supply their own food and drink and can bring their own coal if they wish.

Food & Drink consumption and Waste Disposal

The Multiple Intelligence Hub will provide BBQ facilities to their 'Family Day' Visitors. We cannot however provide food for this purpose. Visitors of this experience will be expected to bring their own food for consumption and disposal of any remaining food items / packaging should be taken with them when they leave. Left over foods should not be given or left for any animals or wildlife to consume, for safety reasons.

Open fires

The Multiple Intelligence Hub will provide facilities for the use of an open fire, these are however at your own risk and MUST be only within the specified areas, where fire pits are provided. All fires must be fully extinguished at the end of your visit, using the equipment provided (Sand/Water buckets). Risk Assessments for such an activity will be made available to all visitors upon their arrival.

Games & Activities

The Multiple Intelligence Hub will provide entertainment activities, in the form of games, woodland crafts and recreational activities. These are however at your own risk and MUST be only within the specified areas. Risk Assessments for all these activities will be made available to all visitors upon their arrival.

Prices

This service has been funded by the Coronavirus Community Support Fund, distributed by the National Lottery Community Fund. We will therefore will not be charging for this service. We are however offering a variety of additions to the experience, which if required as part of your experience, MIH would request for a small donation towards each addition to cover our expenses for this. Site Visits & Parking

Our access point and roadway is shared with surrounding neighbours. Therefore, for safety purposes The Multiple Intelligence Hub offers separate parking facilities for this service, down in the Woodland area, which will be



clearly sign posted and we ask that this is respected and followed by our visitors.

When MIH is closed parking/stopping is not permitted in front of the main gates at any time.
